## Attachment 1

Bidder Questions and Answers by Project Team as of April 8, 2025.

- 1) Will bidders be allowed to take their own samples in Lagoon 5?
  - a. Bidders will be allowed to take their own sludge samples in Lagoon 5. Arrangements must be made in advance with the Maxson plant staff and must use their own equipment. The City of Memphis contact for this purpose will be Noah McClellan who can be reached at [noah.mcclellan@memphistn.gov](mailto:noah.mcclellan@memphistn.gov) or at (901) 636-7123. Bidders considering use of their own boat must submit a Task Safety Plan and a Job Hazard Analysis to Mr. McClellan prior to approval. City of Memphis safety protocols must be followed while on City of Memphis property.
- 2) Will the WWTF staff offer any sampling or testing results on the sludge in Lagoon 5?
  - a. The City of Memphis does anticipate taking up to four samples from four areas or quadrants in the lagoon. The locations of the sample points and results will be made available to all bidders as soon as they are ready.
- 3) What are the projected start and completion dates for the job?
  - a. After the bid date, it is estimated that the City will execute a contract with the winning bidder by September 2025. The contract time is written in the bid documents.
