








This three-year comparison of Part 1 crimes proves that focused strategies, technology, and collaboration are making a measurable difference in our communities.





Year-to-Date Comparison


Across Memphis, every major crime category is down.





Part 1 Crime Reduction Measured YTD



Year-to-Date Monthly Comparison



Year-to-Date Comparison

The City of Memphis experienced a notable improvement in traffic safety in 2025, with crashes decreasing by 10.65% compared to the previous year. In 2024, the Memphis Police Department recorded 31,128 crashes, while in 2025, that number fell to 27,813.
