



FY27 MEMPHIS CITY COUNCIL COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Memphis City Council is preparing to launch the FY27 Memphis City Council Community Grant Program, providing funding opportunities for qualified nonprofit organizations serving residents throughout the City of Memphis.

Organizations whose programs support community development and improve the quality of life for Memphians are encouraged to begin preparing now for the upcoming application period.

Program Priorities

Funding consideration will be given to programs that address one or more of the following priorities:

- Crime and Drug Prevention
- Youth Empowerment
- Economic Development
- Poverty Reduction

Eligibility Highlights

Applicants must:

- Be a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) organization
- Maintain an official address within the City of Memphis
- Have operated under IRS-recognized nonprofit status for at least two (2) years
- Demonstrate current programming and community impact within Memphis
- Attend a mandatory grant workshop

Additional eligibility requirements will be outlined in the official FY27 Grant Resolution and application materials.

Prepare Now

Organizations are encouraged to begin gathering:

- IRS 501(c)(3) Determination Letter
- IRS Form 990, 990-EZ, or 990-N
- IRS Filing Confirmation
- Current W-9
- Certificate of Insurance
- Program and budget information
