

**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2027 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT  
PLAN PROGRAM BUDGET TO COMPLY WITH THE PUBLIC ART PROGRAM  
ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the Memphis City Council approved the FY2027 Capital Improvement Plan on June 23, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Art Program ordinance contains a capital funding requirement that consists of one percent of the total general obligation amount included in the CIP budget, not to exceed \$1 million per fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the adopted FY2027 Capital Improvement Plan budget contains a general obligation bond allocation of \$109,225,008; and

**WHEREAS**; the Percent-For Art Program only received a \$400,000 general obligation allocation in the FY2027 Capital Improvement Plan, of which does not comply with the aforementioned ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**; the Memphis City Council previously approved a \$1 million general bond allocation for MSCS Upgrades in the FY2025 Capital Improvement Plan; and

**WHEREAS**; \$512,000 currently remains unremitted to MSCS as it stabilizes operations and governance; and

**WHEREAS**; the Memphis City Council hereby amends the proposed Capital Improvement Plan Budget for Fiscal Year 2027 by transferring \$512,000 (Five hundred twelve thousand) in general obligation bond allocations from GA07010 FY25 MSCS Upgrades, Contract Construction to EN27105 Urban Arts, Contract Construction; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Memphis City Council hereby amends the adopted Capital Improvement Plan for Fiscal Year 2027 with the allocation and appropriation of \$512,000 in general obligation bond allocations in the following manner:

**FROM:** GA07010 FY25 MSCS Upgrades, Contract Construction

**TO:** EN27105 Urban Arts, Contract Construction
