HCD FY27 Grantees

The City of Memphis Division of Housing and Community Development (HCD) awarded more than \$5.9 million in funding to local nonprofits supporting housing, neighborhood revitalization, and community development initiatives across Memphis for the FY27 Strategic Community Investment Fund (SCIF) Grant cycle.

This is a competitive application process. These investments will support a wide range of services and programs that address critical community needs and advance the City's housing and neighborhood development goals.

FY27 funding awards are made through the following programs:

- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)
- Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA)
- HOME-Funded Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (HOME-TBRA)
- Neighborhood Partnership Grant (NPG)

A total of 10 agencies will receive awards through the federally funded ESG, HOPWA, and HOME-TBRA programs. In addition, 27 agencies will receive grant awards through the City-funded Neighborhood Partnership Grant program. This year, 4 educational institutions will also receive CDBG funds to support their internship programs.

HCD congratulates all award recipients and look forward to partnering with these organizations to deliver meaningful services and lasting investments for Memphis residents and neighborhoods.
